

MAKING A POSTSCRIPT FILE FROM PAGEMAKER

Under File: Go to Document Setup; Choose your size of document. For all sizes of documents – your margins should be: Inside, Outside is .375 and your Top, Bottom is .5

Your target resolution should be set at 600 dpi.

Click OKAY

Under File > PRINT > Choose:

Printer Description: Acrobat Distiller on C:\documents & settings\all users

PPD Description: Acrobat Distiller 3011.104

In Page area > Choose the Number of or Range of pages you want to postscript

In Paper area > choose Tabloid (11 x 17) or Magazine 8.5” x 11” (whichever is your Document size.

In Scale area: make sure your document is set at 100% (do not tile or reduce)

Under Options button > area marked TIFFS/Images section: you want to Send data as: normal. Data encoding: send ASCII image data

In Postscript area: make sure Postscript and True Type fonts appear.

Check the box Write “Postscript File” -- give the file a name and click Browse.

Choose where to send the file: (normally the Desktop). Make sure “Save as type: Normal.ps

Click SAVE

Click the Color button > Frequency should be set at 100 for Color jobs; 85 for Black and White Jobs. Angle doesn't matter it will use the default. Make sure the Composite and Color has a black dot in front.

Click on “Browser button” tell it where to save the file.

Click “SAVE”

Once Saved To the Following:

Open Acrobat Distiller (under the Start Menu)

Choose the press quality.

Drag the postscript file on top of Distiller (which should create the pdf file)
